NOTICE OF NOMINATION MEETING

Notice is hereby given that a Nomination Meeting will be held on **June 27, 2024**, in accordance with the Tla'amin Nation *Election Law (amended May 2020)*, for the purpose of electors nominating candidates for the Office of Hegus (1 position) and for the Office of Legislator (8 positions), for an election of Tla'amin Government to be held on **September 14, 2024**, for the ensuing term of office.

Tla'amin Citizens who are at least eighteen (18) years old as of the election day shall form the Voters List of eligible voters.

An individual may be nominated for office by two other eligible voters, either in-person at the nomination meeting or by mail-in nomination in the prescribed form which must be received by the elections officer prior to the nomination meeting.

Eligibility for nomination as a candidate:

- a) at least 18 years old on the election day;
- b) nominated and seconded at the nomination meeting in accordance with the Election Law;
- c) a Tla'amin Citizen and in good standing with the Tla'amin Nation;
- d) not disqualified from holding office under Tla'amin law;
- e) in the five years immediately preceding election day, not have been convicted of an offence that carried the possibility of imprisonment for two years or more, which was not directly related to the exercise of Aboriginal rights, treaty rights or Aboriginal title;
- f) in the 10 years immediately preceding election day, not have been convicted of an offence that carried the possibility of imprisonment for 10 years or more, which was not directly related to the exercise of Aboriginal rights, treaty rights or Aboriginal title; and
- g) not serving a sentence in a correctional institute at any time during the period from nomination day to election day, inclusive.

A nominee who wishes to stand as a candidate for office must submit the following items to the elections officer no later than July 4, 2024:

- (a) a signed copy of the prescribed Acceptance of Nomination form;
- (b) a non-refundable deposit payable to the Tla'amin Nation in the amount of \$100 for Hegus, or \$50 for Legislator candidates;
- (c) a signed copy of the prescribed Certificate of Qualification form;
- (d) evidence that they have submitted a request for a criminal records check to be forwarded to the elections officer; and
- (e) a signed copy of the Candidate Code of Fair Campaign Practices.

The Election Law, supporting documents, and the official Voters List of all eligible voters shall be available at the TN Government House; can be requested from the Electoral Officer; and shall be available at:
